No drop off, pick up or parking on Gerst Ave


During some contest, the gates may close at any point due to the size of the crowd The administration reserves the right to close the gates to an event at any time.



Counseling-cont'd

*Registration for next year's classes and 6-year plan meetings for all students begins on December 13 and runs until the end of February. Students will receive a presentation on December 13 and 14 and have time to make preliminary

course choices by December 22. These choices will be reviewed with the student's school counselor in one-to-one 6-year plan meetings to make sure they align with future goals. Please encourage this by having conversations about what your child is thinking about doing after high school. Please also encourage them to make preliminary choices in FOCUS between December 13-22. These courses can be adjusted later in the one-to-one meetings with their school counselors. Lastly, schedules can be adjusted in August during the schedule change process. Schedule changes will not be made once the school uear begins.

 Towson, MD - Six Baltimore County Public Schools seniors have been selected to serve as student pages for the 2023 legislative session of the Maryland General Assembly.

The <u>program</u>, created in 1970 by House Speaker Thomas Hunter Lowe and approved by the Maryland State Board of Education, is designed to foster student leadership, educate students about the legislative process, and promote youth interest in government. Student pages are engaged in activities such as distributing materials and messages to legislators, maintaining bill books, and assisting visitors.

During the 13 weeks of the legislative session, which runs from the second week in January to early April, each page will serve for one week during the first seven weeks and returns for a second week of service during the last six weeks of the session.

Each page is paid a stipend of \$55 per day worked to help defray expenses. The page office arranges for students from outside of Anne Arundel County to stay in page housing near the State House for the cost of \$25 per night.

If you qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch this year, you also qualify for benefits such as FREE SAT/ACT TESTS, COLLEGE APPLICATION FEE WAIVERS, AND UNLIMITED SAT SCORE SENDS TO COLLEGES (Juniors and Seniors)!

In order to make sure that you are receiving these benefits, you must fill out and return the Universal Fee Waiver Benefit form, every school year.



Resources for Prospective Students and Families

Perry Hall High School offers the following opportunities to visit and learn more about us.

Parent Visit during American Education Week 11/14-11/18 from 7:45 AM-2:30 PM

Please come prepared with your driver's license/ID to be signed in to the school's Raptor system. During this week parents are able to sign in and come to the School Counseling Office to receive a generic schedule (either academic or advanced academic) and sit in on classes. You will also receive a map to help navigate the school.

Student Shadow Day during American Ed. Week 11/17 from 7:45 AM-2:30 PM

Parents must contact the school counseling office prior to November 19th. Parents (bring ID) will need to escort their student to/from the school counseling office the day of the shadow to sign in/out (PHHS bus transportation is not available for shadows). The school counselor will arrange a student who fits your child's academic needs to shadow. Students are encouraged to participate in a half day shadow in marning or afternoon.
