#### Dear Parents/Guardians-

Perry Hall High School has a tremendous amount to be thankful for. This includes nearly 750 students who made the honor roll first quarter, almost 150 students with a perfect 4.0 GPA first, an amazing musical last weekend, an exciting fall athletics season, and much, much, more. This message includes several important reminders about school procedures. Please spend a few moments reviewing these and, where appropriate, reviewing these with your student.

#### Contact Information

- It is extremely important that school has current contact information for all students. This message is being sent as a voice call and email, if you didn't get both, please contact us.
- As a reminder, anytime your address changes you must notify us. Failure to do so may result in your student being withdrawn.

#### Ready To Learn + Appropriate Clothing

- Device, charger, backpack, paper, and pen or pencil must be brought to school every day.
- Cell phones may not be used during class.
- Families are encouraged to use technology such as "Do Not Disturb" setting on phones to help students be less distracted and more able to focus on their studies.
- Ski masks may not be worn inside.
- Blankets may not be carried.

#### Safety

- Exterior doors may not be opened during the school day.
- Refrain from opening exterior doors for others.
- Food delivery services not permitted, even to the main office.
- Do not leave the school building except to attend a classroom in a trailer or if you have early dismissal.
- Students are not permitted in the wooded area on the edge of the property during school hours.
- Lighters, vapes, and any items associated with smoking or vaping are prohibited on school grounds and at all school events. These items will be confiscated.
- If you see something unsafe or concerning, please tell a staff member. See something, say something!
- All students are assigned a daily lunch period. Students must report to the cafeteria at the assigned time. Students may only leave the cafeteria with a pass.
- Students are reminded that loitering in the restrooms is not allowed at any time.
- Use of the school elevator is limited to students with an approved pass from the health suite.



Grades + Attendance

- Families are encouraged to actively monitor their students' grades and attendance.
- Students who are chronically absent (10% or more of the school days) fail classes nearly 10 times as often as students with low absence rates (3% or less). Attendance Matters!
- Though I don't have data to support this, I am certain that students whose families review their grades with them weekly have much higher grades on average. As the parent of a student in BCPS, I know this is easy to skip, hard to find the time to do, etc. but I know too that it really helps!
- Over 99% of students who fail a class do so because they have missing assignments. This is easily monitored and easily avoidable.
- Parent accounts may be created in Schoology to monitor grades and assignment completion. Schoology also allows families to get email notifications to help with grade monitoring!
- Parents can also monitor their student's records, contact information, report cards and credits, attendance, and more through Focus.
- Directions for both Schoology and Focus can be found at <u>www.BCPS.org</u>, <u>https://perryhallhs.bcps.org</u>, and in most editions of the Communigator (also available on the PHHS website).
- Each teacher at PHHS offers coach class weekly. If your student is missing work or needs help, this is by far the best way to get it! Need even more help? Our National Honor Society offers tutoring too! Details can be found in the Communigator!

#### Dismissal

- Students must exit the building at dismissal.
- Students staying for coach class, extracurriculars or athletics should report directly to those locations.
- Students may not wait for rides inside the building.
- In rare circumstances if a ride is late, students should report to the main office to wait.
- Seniors with early release must leave the building after their last period of the day.

#### Athletics + Extra-Curriculars

- Perry Hall High School students are strongly encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities and/or athletics. A complete list of current extracurricular activities is sent home in the bi-weekly Communigator.
- Student must be in "Good Standing" to attend after school events, including athletic events and dances. Students are considered to be in good standing if they are passing 7 or their 8 classes and have no outstanding obligations (unserved detentions or financial obligations) and have not been suspended in the previous quarter.
- Following evening events at school (athletic events, plays, concerts, etc.) school staff will provide supervision for up to 30 minutes. Families are strongly encouraged to plan ahead for transportation home, and to arrive early when possible.




# Counseling

\*Registration for next year's classes and 6-year plan meetings for all students begins on December 13 and runs until the end of February. Students will receive a presentation on December 13 and 14 and have time to make preliminary course choices by December 22. These choices will be reviewed with the student's school counselor in one-to-one 6-year plan meetings to make sure they align with future goals. Please encourage this by having conversations about what your child is thinking about doing after high school. Please also encourage them to make preliminary choices in FOCUS between December 13-22. These courses can be adjusted later in the one-to-one meetings with their school counselors. Lastly, schedules can be adjusted in August during the

schedule change process. Schedule changes will not be made once the school year begins.






