7 and under and Balto. County School employees with ID are free


Stadium and Gym rules:

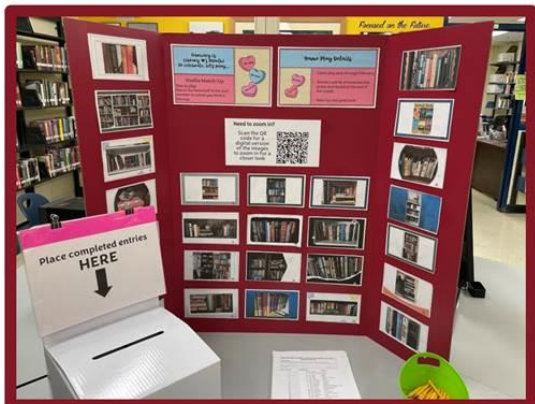

SAT School Day Test: All Juniors

On Tuesday April 25th all juniors will participate in the SAT School Day testing at Perry Hall High School. All PHHS, face-to-face and virtual learning, students will be able to take advantage of this free opportunity; there is not a make-up date. Virtual Learning students please rsvp with Ms. Ortiz, tortiz@bcps.org, by April 1st. The test will provide students with the opportunity to get a baseline score to pursue their post-secondary goals.

We encourage our juniors to eat breakfast, get a good night's sleep Monday evening and be prepared to test for over 4 hours. Students are expected to be on time to school and report to their A1 class to receive their testing pass. Students may bring snacks and water to eat during the section breaks. 
