Six BCPS students named Presidential Scholars candidates for academics

Two previously announced students are candidates for Presidential Scholars in the

Towson, Md. – On the basis of their academic achievements, six Baltimore County Public Schools seniors from five high schools have been named candidates in the prestigious <u>U.S. Presidential Scholars</u> <u>Program.</u>

In addition, two previously announced seniors, <u>Sophia Paffenback and Britney Simbana-J</u>, of George Washington Carver Center for Arts and Technology, are candidates in the U.S. Presidential Scholars Program for their achievements in the arts.

The names of the Presidential Scholars semifinalists will be posted in mid-April, and the names of the 2023 U.S. Presidential Scholars will be posted in early May. Students chosen as U.S. Presidential Scholars receive Presidential medallions.

Each year, up to 161 students are named as Presidential Scholars, one of the nation's highest honors for high school students. The <u>White House Commission on Presidential Scholars</u> selects scholars based on their academic success, artistic and technical excellence, essays, school evaluations and transcripts, as well as a demonstrated commitment to community service and leadership.



All students must have ID's


Middle school age and under must be accompanied by an adult during the entire event




SAT School Day Test: All Juniors

On Tuesday April 25th all juniors will participate in the SAT School Day testing at Perry Hall High School. All PHHS, face-to-face and virtual learning, students will be able to take advantage of this free opportunity; there is not a make-up date. Virtual Learning students please rsup with Ms. Ortiz, tortiz@bcps.org, by April 1st. The test will provide students with the opportunity to get a baseline score to pursue their post-secondary goals.

We encourage our juniors to eat breakfast, get a good night's sleep Monday evening and be prepared to test for over 4 hours. Students are expected to be on time to school and report to their A1 class to receive their testing pass. Students may bring snacks and water to eat during the section breaks. Calculators will be provided but students may bring their own college board approved calculator. 




Student Council



Resources for Prospective Students and Families

Perry Hall High School offers the following opportunities to visit and learn more about us.

Parent Visit during American Education Week 11/14-11/18 from 7:45 AM-2:30 PM

Please come prepared with your driver's license/ID to be signed in to the school's Raptor system. During this week parents are able to sign in and come to the School Counseling Office to receive a generic schedule (either academic or advanced academic) and sit in on classes. You will also receive a map to help navigate the school.

Student Shadow Day during American Ed. Week 11/17 from 7:45 AM-2:30 PM

Parents must contact the school counseling office prior to November 19th. Parents (bring ID) will need to escort their student to/from the school counseling office the day of the shadow to sign in/out (PHHS bus transportation is not available for shadows).
