Omnilert at PHHS - Omnilert is a weapon detection system which utilizes existing internal and external cameras to spot firearms. If a firearm is detected by the system, an alert is sent to designated BCPS and Baltimore County Police Department personnel to respond according to established protocols. Omnilert deployment to BCPS schools began during the Fall of 2023. Perry Hall High School is now among the schools in which the Omnilert system is now being used.

Testing

The state of Maryland requires four tests (English MCAP, Living Systems MISA, Government MCAP, and either Algebra 1, Algebra 2, or Geometry MCAP) for students to be eligible for graduation. Most students will take the English MCAP with their English teacher in their English 10 classroom. Students that are not currently enrolled in an English 10 class will receive a pass for testing and students that are co-enrolled will receive a letter with their testing date and location.

A Day English Classes – April 16, 18, 22, and 24, 2024

B Day English Classes – April 15, 17, 19, and 23, 2024

Information regarding Living Systems MISA, Government MCAP, and Algebra 1, Algebra 2, or Geometry MCAP will be in the next Communicator. Testing for Living Systems MISA, Government MCAP, and Algebra 1, Algebra 2, or Geometry MCAP begins May 1, 2024.

GET PROTECTED AGAINST **MEASLES**

Let's keep measles **OUT** of Baltimore County!

Talk to your provider or visit our health centers to receive the MMR (measles, mumps, and rubella) vaccine.

SYMPTOMS

- Cough
- Red, watery eyes
- Runny nose
- High fever (may spike to more than 104° F)
- Rash breaks out 3 - 5 days after symptoms begin

Baltimore County Health Centers are able to vaccinate both adults and children with the MMR vaccine (measles, mumps and rubella).

- Children should receive their first dose at 1 year and their second dose at 4 - 6 years.
- Adults who have never been vaccinated with MMR should have their first dose as soon as they can.

MEASLES CAN BE SERIOUS



About 1 out of 5 people who get measles will be hospitalized.



1 out of every 1,000 people with measles will develop brain swelling due to infection (encephalitis), which may lead to brain damage.



1 to 3 out of 1,000 people with measles will die, even with the best care.

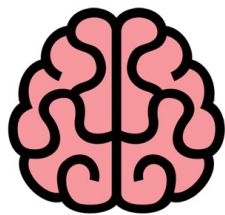
