

Middle school age and under must be accompanied by an adult during the entire event


If you violate any school, or gym rules you will be asked to leave immediately, and you may lose your



SAT School Day Test: All Juniors

On Tuesday April 25th all juniors will participate in the SAT School Day testing at Perry Hall High School. All PHHS, face-to-face and virtual learning, students will be able to take advantage of this free opportunity; there is not a make-up date. Virtual Learning students please rsup with Ms. Ortiz, tortiz@bcps.org, by April 1st. The test will provide students with the opportunity to get a baseline score to pursue their post-secondary goals.

We encourage our juniors to eat breakfast, get a good night's sleep Monday evening and be prepared to test for over 4 hours. Students are expected to be on time to school and report to their A1 class to receive their testing pass. Students may bring snacks and water to eat during the section breaks. Calculators will be provided but students may bring their own college board

2023 Student Leadership Summer Expeditions

Expeditions primarily take place outdoors where participants explore different parts of the watershed and engage with CBF staff, field experts, and scientists. All transportation, lodging, and meals are provided during the expeditions. Participants are expected to participate in meal preparation. Overnight accommodations may include camping (tents provided), dorm-style housing, or a combination of the two.

- COVID Policy: Review our updated COVID policy in the blue box above.
- Cancellation Policy: Cancellations made before June 1 will receive a full refund minus a \$75 processing fee. No refunds will be granted after June 1; however, we are happy to transfer registration to another course, based on availability. All cancellation requests must be made in writing. Email chesapeakeclassrooms@cbf.org to request a cancellation or transfer.
- Cost: Generous support from CBF donors and grants allow us to offer our weekdong expeditions for \$500. The actual cost to run these courses is more than \$2000 per participant. Financial assistance is available.
